



What is BREADA?

BREADA (/bred-uh/) stands for Big River Economic & Agricultural Development Alliance. We are the nonprofit organization behind the Red Stick Farmers Market. BREADA is based in Baton Rouge, but the "BR" stands for Big River because our farmers and vendors come from 17 parishes across South Louisiana.
